**Report Summary:**

- During the LCC meeting on Wednesday, 9/15/2021, the LCC passed a motion to release the RFP on or before 10/15/2021.
- The legislative division directors completed a final review of the RFP the week of 9/27/2021.
- The draft RFP was provided to President Masterson and Speaker Pro Tem Finch on Friday, 10/1/2021.
- Speaker Pro Tem Finch provided some edits to the RFP the week of 10/4/2021. The edits were incorporated into the document.
- Speaker Pro Tem Finch and President Masterson gave their approval of the RFP on Thursday, 10/7/2021.
- The RFP was release for bid submission on Monday, 10/11/2021. The RFP was posted on the Legislature's website and on the website of the Office of Procurement and Contracts in the Department of Administration. The contract was also transmitted to 6 vendors with experience in Legislative Systems.
- The RFP will be open for 6 weeks for bid submission. The proposal due date is Monday, 11/22/2021. Vendors have until Monday, 11/1/2021 to submit questions on the RFP.
- The systems implementation date in the RFP is set on 10/1/2024.
- At this time no questions or bid submissions have been received.
