Dear Chairperson Masterson:

As Chairperson of the Joint Committee on State Building Construction, I respectfully request three additional meeting days during the 2023 Interim Session. Three additional days are necessary to study, review, and make recommendations on all agency five-year capital improvement plans; and travel within the state to observe the many state-owned buildings. The Committee would like to travel to Osawatomie State Hospital; the Shawnee Indian Mission Historical Site; a correctional facility; and tour some of the Wildlife and Parks cabins in Kansas.

The Joint Committee is authorized by KSA 46-1701, which includes provisions allowing the Joint Committee to meet on call of its Chairperson at any time and any place within the state and to introduce legislation. I request two additional days in Topeka to review the agency five-year capital improvement plans and one additional day to travel outside of Topeka to view the state's buildings that may be undergoing renovation or construction.



As the Chairperson of the Joint Committee on Information Technology, I request Legislative Coordinating Council (LCC) approval of one additional meeting day for the 2023 Legislative Interim Session.

On June 5, 2023, the LCC authorized four meeting days for the Joint Committee. Earlier this month, the Kansas Judicial Branch experienced a security incident that is impacting court services provided throughout the state. The Joint Committee had a meeting scheduled for October 18, 2023, and was able to receive a briefing about the security incident at that meeting. As a result of the necessary agenda change, many of the presentations originally scheduled for that meeting had to be postponed. I would request one additional day for the Joint Committee to meet this interim to receive the presentations that were postponed and to receive another briefing about the Judicial Branch security incident.
